Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import for Adobe is an Adobe Import plugin for Premiere Pro and Media Encoder that enables you to import Panasonic AVC-Intra LT MXF files into Premiere Pro and Media Encoder CC 2015.4 or 2017

Please note that realtime playback is not guaranteed

Please note that if ever Adobe implements native AVC-Intra LT MXF file importing then Adobe projects that were created with the Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import plugin may still need the Calibrated plugin installed for that project to use AVC-Intra LT MXF files that were imported with the plugin.

Compatible MXF Files

Panasonic AVC-Intra LT OP1b MXF files with Premiere Pro or AME 2015.4 or 2017

Windows Requirements and Installation

Ensure your PC meets the following requirements prior to installing Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import:

- 64-bit Windows 7 or greater
- CPU supporting SSE4.1 or higher
- Adobe CC 2015.4 or 2017
- (Adobe CC to Adobe CC 2014 products should work but have not been extensively tested or are supported)
- Please note that realtime playback is not guaranteed

Please note that if ever Adobe implements native AVC-Intra LT MXF file importing then Adobe projects that were created with the Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import plugin may still need the Calibrated plugin installed for that project to use AVC-Intra LT MXF files that were imported with the plugin.

Installing on Windows

To install Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import on a Windows Computer:

1. Quit any Adobe applications.
2. Run the Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import Installer. The install program creates a folder named **Calibrated** in the *[System Drive]\[Program Files]* directory and auto copy the plugin into the Adobe plugin directory
3. Restart your computer

Uninstalling on Windows

To uninstall Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import on a Windows Computer:

1. Go to the **Control Panel>Add/Remove Programs**.
2. Select and uninstall **Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import** from the list of programs.
3. Restart your computer.

Mac OSX Requirements and Installation

Ensure your Mac meets the following requirements prior to installing Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import:

- 10.9.4 (Mavericks) or 10.10 (Yosemite) or 10.11 (El Capitan)
- Mac Intel with SSE4.1 and greater support
- Adobe CC 2015.4 or 2017
- (Adobe CC to Adobe CC 2014 products should work but have not been extensively tested or are supported)
- Please note that realtime playback is not guaranteed
- Please note that if ever Adobe implements native AVC-Intra LT MXF file importing then Adobe projects that were created with the Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import plugin may still need the Calibrated plugin installed for that project to use AVC-Intra LT MXF files that were imported with the plugin.

Installing on Mac OSX

To install Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import on a Mac Computer:

1. Quit any Adobe applications.

Run the Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import Installer. The install program creates a folder named **Calibrated** in the */Applications* directory and auto copy the plugin into the Adobe plugin directory

2. Restart your computer

Uninstalling on Mac OSX

To uninstall Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import on a Mac Computer:

1. **Delete the imCalibratedAVCIntraLT.bundle from the folder /Library/Application Support/Adobe/Common/Plug-ins/7.0/MediaCore (please note that this is the Library folder in the Main Harddrive NOT the Library folder in the User Directory)**

2. Restart your computer.

Getting Started

1. Make sure you have updated to Premiere Pro or AME 2015.4 or 2017

Import into Premiere Pro

Open Premiere Pro or AME and import a Panasonic AVC-Intra LT OP1b MXF file like you normally would into Premiere Pro. If the AVC-Intra LT MXF file is the Top of a spanned clipped then it will import the rest of the span with it as a single clip.

- Please note that realtime playback is not guaranteed
- Please note that if ever Adobe implements native AVC-Intra LT MXF file importing then Adobe projects that were created with the Calibrated AVC-Intra LT Import plugin may still need the Calibrated plugin installed for that project to use AVC-Intra LT MXF files that were imported with the plugin.
